LB 747

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 747 amends NEB 37-202 and 37-559, Reissue Revised Statutes of NEB and section 37-201 permits the killing of mountain lions and other predatory animals. This bill allows any landowner to kill a mountain lion immediately without prior notice or permission from the Game and Parks Commission if he or she encounters a mountain lion in the process of stalking, killing, or consuming livestock on his or her property.

The Commission may issue a permit for the killing of one or mountain lions which are preying on livestock or poultry. The permit shall be valid for up to 30 days.
