The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 772 increases the penalties for an individual operating a motor vehicle while his or her license has been revoked. Specifically, LB 772 provides that any person operating a motor vehicle in violation of the Nebraska Rules of the Road while his or her operator's license has been revoked, shall, as part of his or her subsequent judgment of conviction, have his or her operator's license revoked for a period of time equal to the revocation period the person was subject to at the time of their current offense.
