The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 870 amends section 53-149 of the Liquor Control Act by creating a temporary operator's permit. Under this bill, once an establishment is sold, the seller's liquor license is immediately terminated and the buyer could apply for a temporary operator's permit to continue to operate the establishment until the buyer's application for a new license is processed.
