The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 900 amends section 53-124 of the Liquor Control Act by creating a different annual liquor license fee based on whether the establishment is located in a city of the metropolitan class, a city of the primary class, or any other location in Nebraska.

For a Class A liquor license, the fee would be \$300 in a city of the metropolitan class, \$200 in a city of the primary class, and \$100 in any other location in Nebraska.

For a Class B liquor license, the fee would be \$300 in a city of the metropolitan class, \$200 in a city of the primary class, and \$100 in any other location in Nebraska.

For a Class C liquor license, the fee would be \$1,000 in a city of the metropolitan class, \$500 in a city of the primary class, and \$300 in any other location in Nebraska.

For a Class D liquor license, the fee would be \$750 in a city of the metropolitan class, \$500 in a city of the primary class, and \$250 in any other location in Nebraska.

For a Class I liquor license, the fee would be \$750 in a city of the metropolitan class, \$500 in a city of the primary class, and \$250 in any other location in Nebraska.
