The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB933 would expand the type of proof of ownership required from a certificate of title applicant to include an affidavit by the owner affirming ownership that comes along with county assessor assessment records for the manufactured home or mobile home. The bill further provides that for an applicant who cannot produce the required proof of ownership, the certificate of title may still be issued if the department finds that other evidence provided by the applicant is sufficient.

This bill represents a reasonable and workable solution to a problem that has arisen for lenders and mobile and manufactured home owners alike as they attempt to comply with the Motor Vehicle Certificate of Title Act.
