

One Hundred First Legislature - Second Session - 2010 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 939

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB939 changes child support enforcement provisions relating to the collection of other monetary judgments, mandatory reporting of account balances and review and modification of child support orders:

- LB 939 allows for the collection of other monetary judgments (i.e. genetic testing) that a child support obligor continues to owe after his/her child support obligation is current
- LB 939 also changes provisions relating to mandatory reporting of account information by financial institutions by adding the requirement that financial institutions also remit the delinquent obligor's account balance.
- Finally, LB 939 addresses federal requirements by allowing the Department to modify health
 care coverage cases within 3 years of the entry of the child support order and to review child
 support orders when there has been a substantial change in circumstances such as changes in
 employment, earnings capacity, income, or receipt of an ongoing source of income from
 pension, gift or lottery winning.
