

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 105A

Approved by the Governor April 8, 2009

Introduced by Langemeier, 23.

FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 105, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session, 2009.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$200,000 from the Nebraska Habitat Fund for FY2009-10 and (2) \$400,000 from the Nebraska Habitat Fund for FY2010-11 to the Game and Parks Commission, for Program 330, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 105, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session, 2009.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$182,300 from the Nebraska Aquatic Habitat Fund for FY2009-10 and (2) \$284,600 from the Nebraska Aquatic Habitat Fund for FY2010-11 to the Game and Parks Commission, for Program 336, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 105, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session, 2009.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$67,500 for FY2009-10 or \$69,100 for FY2010-11.
