

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 190A

Approved by the Governor March 3, 2010

Introduced by Avery, 28.

FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to provide for a transfer; and to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 190, One Hundred First Legislature, Second Session, 2010.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The State Treasurer shall transfer \$176,000 from the State Settlement Cash Fund to the State DNA Sample and Data Base Fund on or before August 1, 2010.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated \$72,800 from the State DNA Sample and Data Base Fund for FY2010-11 to the Department of Correctional Services, for Program 200, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 190, One Hundred First Legislature, Second Session, 2010.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated \$103,200 from the State DNA Sample and Data Base Fund for FY2010-11 to the Nebraska State Patrol, for Program 100, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 190, One Hundred First Legislature, Second Session, 2010.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$50,000 from the Department of Correctional Services Facility Cash Fund for FY2010-11 and (2) \$50,000 from the Department of Correctional Services Facility Cash Fund for FY2011-12 to the Department of Correctional Services, for Program 200, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 190, One Hundred First Legislature, Second Session, 2010.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$34,500 from the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund for FY2010-11 and (2) \$34,500 from the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund for FY2011-12 to the Nebraska State Patrol, for Program 100, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 190, One Hundred First Legislature, Second Session, 2010.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.
