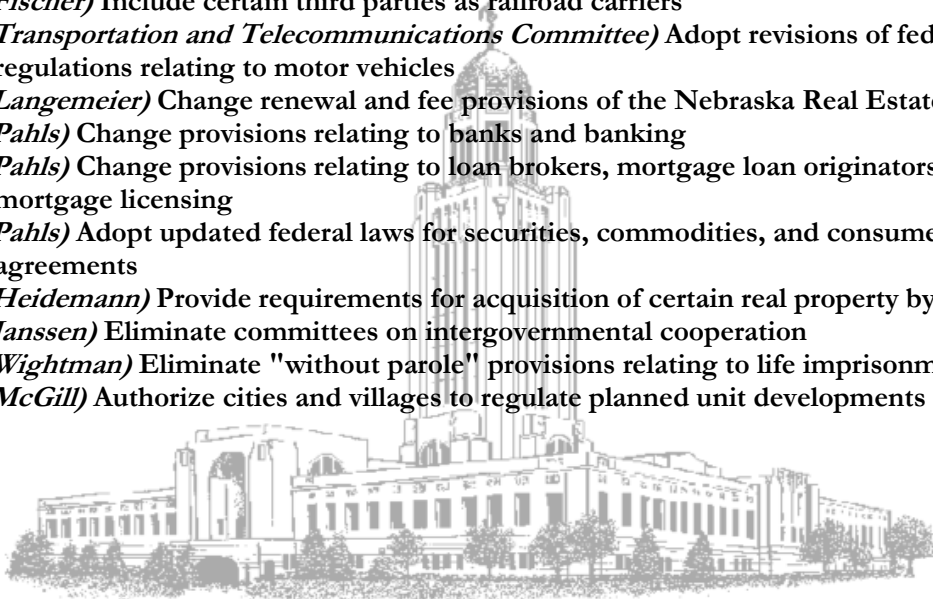
- LB 1 (*Executive Board*) Revisor bill to repeal an obsolete statute relating to the Republican River
- LB 2 (*Executive Board*) Revisor bill to repeal obsolete statutes relating to the Water Policy Task Force, ground water conservation districts, and certain provisional permits
- LB 3 (*Executive Board*) Revisor bill to repeal an obsolete statute in the Nebraska Construction Lien Act governing the enforcement of liens that arose prior to January 1, 1982
- LB 4 (*Executive Board*) Revisor bill to repeal an obsolete statute relating to the Small Business Development Authority and the Small Business Investment Fund
- LB 5 (*Executive Board*) Revisor bill to repeal an obsolete statute relating to the Research and Development Authority
- LB 6 (*Executive Board*) Revisor bill to eliminate obsolete language and reference to a repealed statute in the Judges Retirement Act relating to acting judges of the county court
- LB 7 (*Executive Board*) Revisor bill to repeal an obsolete statute relating to workers' compensation
- LB 8 (*Executive Board*) Revisor bill to repeal an obsolete statute relating to schools
- LB 9 (*Executive Board*) Revisor bill to change erroneous reference to previous sections rather than chapter in civil procedure statutes
