- LB 387 (*Hadley, at the request of the Governor*) Adopt the Business Innovation Act and eliminate economic development programs

GENERAL FILE: 2011 SPEAKER PRIORITY BILLS – “CAMPBELL DIVISION”

- LB 541 (*Health and Human Services Committee*) Provide for third-party contracts to promote medicaid integrity and cost containment
- LB 465 (*Campbell, at the request of the Governor*) Eliminate provisions relating to eligibility of non-United-States citizens for public assistance
- LB 385 (*Utter, at the request of the Governor*) Terminate provisions of the Low-Income Home Energy Conservation Act
- LB 468 (*Campbell, at the request of the Governor*) Change reporting provisions relating to the medical assistance program

- LB 329 (*Cook*) Update the International Energy Conservation Code and change Nebraska Energy Code provisions
- LB 90 (*Harr*) Change provisions relating to secured transactions under Article 9 of the Uniform Commercial Code
- LB 509 (*Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee*) Change provisions relating to retirement

- LB 490 (*Karpisek*) Change restrictions on keno

GENERAL FILE: 2011 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS – “PIRSCH DIVISION”

- LB 479 (*Lathrop*) Authorize a minor to give consent to evidence collection and examination and treatment in cases of sexual assault
- LB 200 (*Council*) Adopt the Nebraska Healthy Food Financing Initiative Act
- LB 176 (*Avery*) Authorize the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission to order violators to pay hearing costs
- LR 40CA (*Pirsch*) Constitutional amendment to declare fishing, trapping, and hunting to be rights forever preserved subject to reasonable restrictions

GENERAL FILE: 2011 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS – “LARSON DIVISION”

- LB 407 (*Karpisek*) Provide for mail and electronic delivery of certain notices under the Nebraska Liquor Control Act
- LB 95 (*Howard*) Require accreditation for lead agencies contracting with the Department of Health and Human Services
- LB 112 (*Coash*) Provide an exemption from motor carrier regulations for comprehensive services transport
- LB 305 (*Larson*) Implement a state meat and poultry inspection program

- LB 35 (*Harms*) Change provisions relating to oversize vehicle permits
- LB 204 (*Council*) Require blood-lead testing prior to enrollment in school

- LB 558 (*Nordquist*) Change provisions relating to focus schools, focus programs, and magnet schools

- LB 698 (*Christensen*) Eliminate labeling requirements for alcohol-blended fuel
- LB 388 (*Wightman*) Adopt the Site and Building Development Act and change provisions relating to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund
- LB 606 (*Avery*) Require reporting of electioneering communication under the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act
- LB 283 (*Haar*) Provide school boards with tax levy and bond authority relating to energy efficiency projects
