- LB 698 *(Christensen)* Eliminate labeling requirements for alcohol-blended fuel
- LB 388 *(Wightman, at the request of the Governor)* Adopt the Site and Building Development Act and change provisions relating to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund
- LB 388A *(Wightman)* Appropriation Bill
- LB 606 *(Avery)* Require reporting of electioneering communication under the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act
- LB 283 *(Haar)* Provide school boards with tax levy and bond authority relating to energy efficiency projects

- LB 479 *(Lathrop)* Authorize a minor to give consent to evidence collection and examination and treatment in cases of sexual assault
- LB 200 *(Council)* Adopt the Nebraska Healthy Food Financing Initiative Act
- LB 176 *(Avery)* Authorize the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission to order violators to pay hearing costs
- LR 40CA *(Pirsch)* Constitutional amendment to declare fishing, trapping, and hunting to be rights forever preserved subject to reasonable restrictions

- LB 305 *(Larson)* Implement a state meat and poultry inspection program

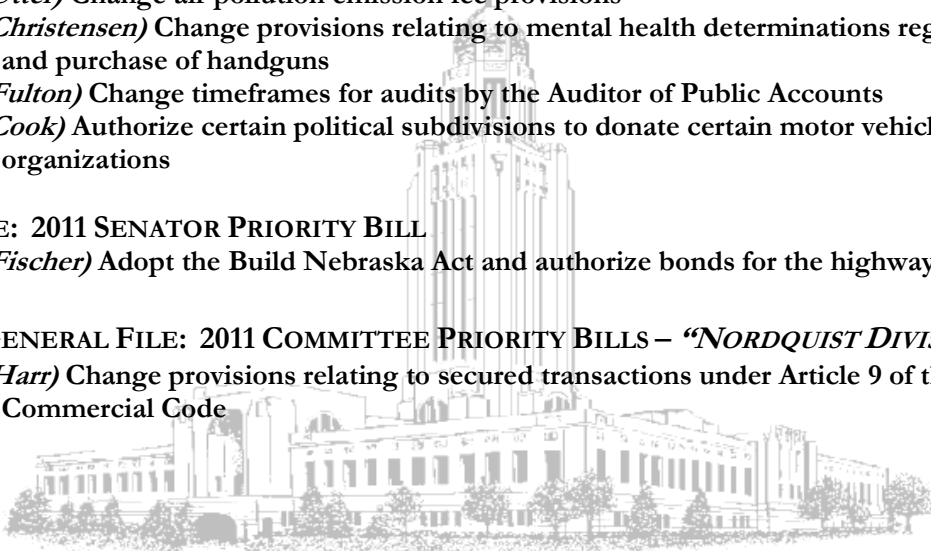
