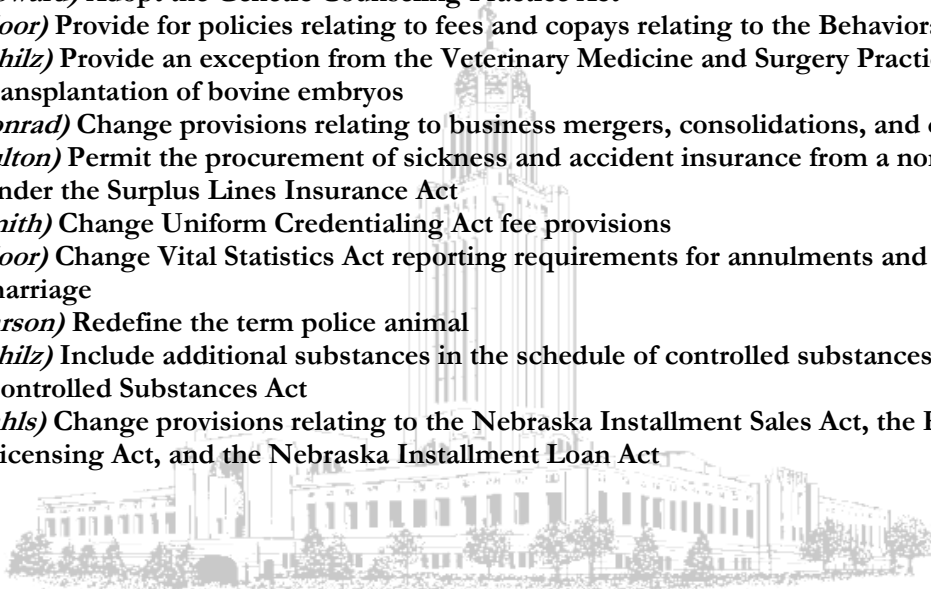

- LB 779 *(Lautenbaugh)* Provide for rental of vehicles for use by state agencies
- LB 719 *(Price)* Change and eliminate provisions of the Records Management Act, transmission of reports, and certain surcharge and convenience fees
- LB 735 *(Schumacher)* Provide for public meetings of a community college board of governors to be held by videoconference or telephone conference
- LB 818 *(Harr)* Exempt certain deeds from the documentary stamp tax
- LB 489 *(Cornett)* Authorize municipalities to receive sales tax information
