Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 130 would amend section 79-1022 by allowing the Department of Education to proportionately adjust the formula need for each district if the amount appropriated for school fiscal years 2011-12 or 2012-13 is different than the amount calculated for distribution. The adjustment would cause the calculated aid to equal the appropriation.

The measure contains an emergency clause.
