## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The bill as drafted removes a reference to the abstract of assessment for personal property. Current law provides for county assessors to file a report called an abstract of real and personal property. This is to be filed with the State Property Tax Administrator, an employee of the Tax Commissioner of the Department of Revenue. The change would leave property listings out of the abstract.
