Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 225 removes, under the Uniform Credentialing Act, the restriction that credentials for nonimmigrants are issued only to nonimmigrants whose visa for entry, or application for visa for entry, is related to employment in the United States.

The bill allows a credential to be issued to a United States citizen, an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence, or a nonimmigrant lawfully present in the United States who is eligible for credentials under the Uniform Credentialing Act.
