Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 243 would provide for an additional member to the Republican River Basin Water Sustainability Task Force. The task force was created last session through passage of LB 1057. The intent of that bill was to include all senators representing districts containing any portion of the Republican River Basin on the task force. This bill would simply add a spot on the task force for a senator whose district is in the basin but was not accounted for in LB 1057.

Section 1 amends 46-2,140, which creates the Republican River Basin Water Sustainability Task Force, by requiring the Legislature's Executive Board to appoint five (rather than four) ex officio members and providing that two (rather than one) members must have a portion of their legislative district in the basin.

Section 2 repeals the original section.

Section 3 contains an emergency clause.
