Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 373, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor, is part of the Governor's biennial budget recommendations. This bill makes adjustments to funding for state operations, aid and construction programs in the current fiscal year (deficits), ending June 30, 2011. The appropriations will be used in programs where the forecasted cost has risen or decreased due to circumstances that were unforeseen when the budget bills were passed two years ago and subsequently amended by the Legislature in 2010.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment become the bill. The amendment reflects the Appropriations Committee recommendations for adjustments for deficits in the current FY2010-11.
