Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 377, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor, is a component of the Governor's biennial budget recommendations. This bill appropriates funds for reaffirmed and new construction projects recommended by the Governor for the 2011-13 biennium. Reaffirmed projects include those projects that have previously been approved by the Legislature for funding.
