## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 668 would amend 28-456.01 (Pseudoephedrine or phenylpropanolamine; limitation on acquisition; violation; penalty.) which provides a prohibition on the purchase, receipt, or otherwise acquiring by a person more than three and six-tenths grams of pseudoephedrine base or three and six-tenths grams of phenylpropanolamine during a twenty four hour period. A violation of this prohibition would now be a Class IV misdemeanor (\$100-\$500 fine) for the first offense and a Class III misdemeanor (3 months/\$500/ or both) for each subsequent offense.

LB 668 would also provide a new limitation in statute on the amount of pseudoephedrine base or phenylpropanolamine base that a person could purchase per month absent a medical order, with such limitation being nine grams per drug. The penalty for violating this provision would be a Class IV misdemeanor (\$100-\$500 fine) for a first offense and a Class III misdemeanor (3 months/\$500/ or both) for each subsequent offense.
