Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 701 changes district boundaries for members of the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska by the adoption of maps by reference.

The state is divided into eight regent districts. The overall range of deviation is approximately 2 percent. Districts are drawn using census geography and population data from the 2010 US Census.

The maps will be kept on file in the Secretary of State's office.

LB 701 includes an emergency clause.
