Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 702 changes district boundaries for members of the State Board of Education by the adoption of maps by reference.

The state is divided into eight districts. The overall range of deviation is approximately 2 percent. Districts are drawn using census geography and population data from the 2010 US Census.

The maps will be kept on file in the Secretary of State's office.

LB 702 includes an emergency clause.
