Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 711 changes the membership of the three caucuses for the at-large members of the Executive Board to reflect changes brought about from the 2011 redistricting process.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment strikes the original provisions of the bill and divides the members of the Legislature into three Executive Board caucuses on the basis which congressional district has a majority of the population of a particular legislative district.
