Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The bill adds that "a nurse practitioner or a licensed physician assistant" may order respiratory care in addition to the current law that allows a licensed physician to order respiratory care.

Explanation of amendments:

Current law provides that only licensed physicians may order respiratory care. LB 788 provides that "nurse practitioners and licensed physician assistants" are to be added; with the changes in the amendment, "certified registered nurse anesthetists" are added to the list.

The amendment strikes the original bill and becomes the bill. Therefore, the amendment adds "nurse practitioner, licensed physician assistants and certified registered nurse anesthetist" to those authorized to order respiratory care services.
