Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 800 would amend section 72-258.03 to provide that the appraised value used for purposes of sales of educational land at public auction would be determined by the Board of Educational Lands and Funds. Pursuant to current statute, such appraised value is to be established pursuant to sections 72-257 or 72-258. Section 72-257 references the appointment by the Board of a certified general real property appraiser in conducting appraisals of educational land prior to sale.
