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Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would enact a new section to provide that an individual or group health policy, certificate, contract, agreement, or plan shall not include a provision, stipulation, or agreement establishing or limiting any fees charged for dental services that are not covered by the policy, certificate, contract, or agreement, or plan. This section would apply to an individual or group sickness or accident policy, certificate, or contract; a hospital, medical, or surgical expense-incurred policy; a self-funded employee benefit plan to the extent not preempted by federal law; and a certificate, agreement, or contract issued by a prepaid limited health service organization.
