Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 898 increases the allowed engine size within the definition of a minitruck.

The bill amends the definition of "minitruck" within the Certificate of Title Act, the Registration Act, the Financial Responsibility Act, and the Rules of the Road so that a minitruck can have an engine with a piston or rotor displacement of 1,500 cubic centimeters or less.

Current law authorizes displacement of 1000 cubic centimeters or less.
