LB 60 would amend the Nebraska Liquor Control Act Section 53-1,122 dealing with the use of minors for compliance checks.

The bill adds language prohibiting law enforcement officers and minors conducting compliance checks from consuming alcoholic liquor.

The bill also adds language that requires a minor assisting in a compliance check to tell the truth about their age if asked by the retailer. The bill has no fiscal impact to the state.
