This bill would authorize the voluntary waiver of compensation by jurors. The bill also adds the provision allowing the county clerk to deduct the amount for juror compensation for real estate taxes then due from the juror.

It appears that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the state.

IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS: This bill could impact counties since it allows jurors to waive compensation for service as a juror. Counties may also be impacted because the bill allows delinquent real estate taxes to be deducted from juror compensation.

At this time, it is unknown how these provisions could impact counties.
