LB 996 relates to the mandatory attendance age for children to attend school. The bill eliminates current language allowing a parent or guardian to sign a notarized release discontinuing the enrollment of a child who has reached age sixteen.

Data compiled by NDE shows that 1,911 students, age 16 and above, dropped out of public schools in 2009-10. This equates to approximately .006% of statewide public school enrollment. The State Department of Education (NDE) does not have data showing how many of the dropouts, aged 16 and above, filed a notarized release as a prerequisite to discontinuing enrollment.

It is assumed the bill will result in a minimal increase in student membership beginning in 2012-13. The increase in student membership pursuant to LB 996 is projected to have a minimal impact in terms of increased spending by school districts. However, increases in student membership may result in changes in state aid for school districts. Since the number of students impacted by the bill is projected to be small, any impact on state aid is estimated to be minimal.
