A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to the Building Construction Act; to amend section 71-6405, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2011; to eliminate provisions relating to amendments to the state building code by state agencies; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 71-6405, Revised Statutes Supplement,

2011, is amended to read:

3 71-6405 All state agencies, including all state 4 constitutional offices, state administrative departments, and state 5 boards and commissions, the University of Nebraska, and the Nebraska 6 state colleges, shall comply with the state building code. No state 7 agency may adopt, promulgate, or enforce any rule or regulation in 8 conflict with the state building code unless otherwise specifically 9 authorized by statute to adopt or enforce a building or construction code other than the state building code. Nothing in the Building 10 Construction Act shall authorize any state agency to apply such act 11 12 to manufactured homes or recreational vehicles regulated by the 13 Uniform Standard Code for Manufactured Homes and Recreational Vehicles or to modular housing units regulated by the Nebraska 14 15 Uniform Standards for Modular Housing Units Act. A state agency may, 16 by rule or regulation, amend the state building code by adopting any 17 supplement or appendix of the International Building Code (IBC), 2009 18 edition, International Residential Code (IRC), 2009 edition, or the 19 International Existing Building Code, 2009 edition, referred to in 20 section 71-6403, except that all amendments shall be approved in 21 advance by the Director of Administrative Services. Amendments to the 22 state building code may also include variations from the code which 23 will reduce unnecessary costs of construction, increase safety, 24 durability, or efficiency, or address special local conditions within 25 the state and may include adoption of section R313 of the 2009
