6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-401, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1 2 2011, is amended to read: 3 71-401 Sections 71-401 to 71-467 and section 2 of this 4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Health Care Facility 5 Licensure Act. 6 Sec. 2. In order to prevent, detect, and control 7 pneumonia and influenza outbreaks in Nebraska, each general acute 8 hospital, intermediate care facility, nursing facility, and skilled nursing facility shall annually, beginning no later than October 1 9 10 and ending on the following April 1 when no national vaccine shortage exists, offer onsite vaccinations for influenza and pneumococcal 11 12 disease to all residents and to all inpatients prior to discharge, 13 pursuant to procedures of the facility and in accordance with the recommendations of the advisory committee on immunization practices 14 of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention of the United 15 States Public Health Service of the United States Department of 16 Health and Human Services as the recommendations existed on January 17 1, 2012. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require any 18 facility listed in this section to cover the cost of a vaccination 19 20 provided pursuant to this section. Sec. 3.
