A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Campaign Finance Limitation Act; to amend
2 section 32-1608, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3 change a contribution limit as prescribed; and to repeal
4 the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 32-1608, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 32-1608 During the election period, no candidate for a
4 covered elective office shall accept contributions from independent
5 committees, businesses, including corporations, unions, industry,
6 trade, or professional associations, and political parties which,
7 when aggregated, are in excess of ~~fifty-seventy-five~~ percent of the
8 spending limitation for the office set pursuant to section 32-1604.
9 The commission shall calculate the limitation on contributions under
10 this section at the time it calculates the adjustments on the
11 campaign spending limitations under section 32-1604. The commission
12 shall publish the new contribution limits on its web site and shall
13 notify any candidate who files for an office which is subject to the
14 spending limitation of the contribution limits applicable at the time
15 of filing.
