Section 1. Section 38-129, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 38-129 No individual shall be issued a credential under 4 Uniform Credentialing Act until he or she has furnished the 5 satisfactory evidence to the department that he or she is of good б character and has attained the age of nineteen years except as 7 otherwise specifically provided by statute, rule, or regulation. A 8 credential may only be issued to a citizen of the United States, an 9 alien lawfully admitted into the United States who is eligible for a credential under the Uniform Credentialing Act, or a nonimmigrant 10 11 whose visa for entry, or application for visa for entry, is related 12 to such employment in the United States. lawfully present in the 13 United States who is eligible for a credential under the Uniform 14 Credentialing Act.

Sec. 2. Original section 38-129, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effectwhen passed and approved according to law.
