7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. Section 49-14,120, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2	Nebraska, is amended to read:
3	49-14,120 The Secretary of State shall receive no
4	compensation for services as a commission member other than any
5	salary allowed by law, but All members of the commission shall be
б	reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses. The appointed members
7	shall be paid a per diem of fifty dollars for each day actually and
8	necessarily engaged in the performance of their duties as members of
9	such commission in addition to such expense allowance. Reimbursement
10	for expenses shall be as provided in sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.
11	Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2011.
12	Sec. 3. Original section 49-14,120, Reissue Revised
13	Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
14	Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
15	when passed and approved according to law.
