FOR AN ACT relating to infants; to amend section 43-536, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions
relating to child care reimbursement; to harmonize
provisions; to provide an operative date; to repeal the
original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 43-536, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 43-536 In determining the rate of reimbursement for child
- 4 care, the Department of Health and Human Services shall conduct a
- 5 market rate survey of the child care providers in the state. The
- 6 department shall adjust the reimbursement rate for child care every
- 7 odd-numbered year at a rate not less than the sixtieth percentile and
- 8 not to exceed the seventy-fifth percentile of the current market rate
- 9 survey, except that (1) nationally accredited child care providers
- 10 may be reimbursed at higher rates and (2) for the two fiscal years
- 11 beginning July 1, 2003, 2011, such rate may not be less than the
- 12 sixtieth fiftieth percentile but shall not be less than or the rate
- 13 for the immediately preceding fiscal year.
- 14 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2011.
- Sec. 3. Original section 43-536, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 16 of Nebraska, is repealed.
- 17 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 18 when passed and approved according to law.
