- FOR AN ACT relating to libraries; to amend sections 16-251 and 2 51-211, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide requirements for approval of personnel policies and 3 procedures as prescribed; and to repeal the original 5 sections. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,
