Section 38-155, Reissue Revised Statutes of 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 38-155 (1) The department, with the recommendation of the appropriate board if applicable, or the Water Well Standards and 4 5 Contractors' Licensing Board as provided in section 38-151, shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to establish and collect б 7 the fees for the following credentials: 8 (a) Initial credentials, which include, but are not 9 limited to: (i) Licensure, certification, or registration; 10 (ii) Add-on or specialty credentials; 11 12 (iii) Temporary, provisional, or training credentials; 13 and 14 (iv) Supervisory or collaborative relationship credentials; 15 (b) Applications to renew licenses, certifications, and 16 registrations; 17 (c) Approval of continuing education courses and other 18 methods of continuing competency; and 19 20 (d) Inspections and reinspections. (2) When a credential will expire within one hundred 21 eighty days after its initial issuance date or its reinstatement date 22 23 and the initial credentialing or renewal fee is twenty-five dollars or more, the department shall collect twenty-five dollars or one-24 fourth of the initial credentialing or renewal fee, whichever is 25

greater, for the initial <u>or reinstated credential. The initial or</u> <u>reinstated</u>, and the credential shall be valid until the next subsequent renewal date.
