1	FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section 28-1416,
2	Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3	provisions relating to justification for use of force; to
4	harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.
5	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-1416, Reissue Revised Statutes of 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 28-1416 (1) In any prosecution based on conduct which is 4 justifiable under sections 28-1406 to 28-1416, justification is an 5 affirmative defense. б (2) The fact that conduct is justifiable under sections 7 28-1406 to 28-1416 does not abolish or impair any remedy for such 8 conduct which is available in any civil action. 9 (2) The justification defenses provided for under sections 28-1406 to 28-1416 shall be available in any civil action 10 11 for assault and battery or intentional wrongful death and, where 12 applicable, shall be a bar to recovery. Sec. 2. Original section 28-1416, Reissue Revised 13 14 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
