**LEGISLATIVE BILL 949A**

Final Reading

Introduced by Harms, 48.

Read first time March 20, 2012

A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend Laws 2011, LB374,  
2 section 101; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out  
3 the provisions of Legislative Bill 949, One Hundred  
4 Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012; to provide for  
5 transfers of funds; to provide for a reduction of  
6 appropriations as prescribed; to repeal the original  
7 section; and to declare an emergency.  
8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$156,111,873 from  
 2 the General Fund, \$2,734,444 from Cash Funds, and \$30,676,983 from  
 3 federal funds for FY2012-13 to the Department of Health and Human  
 4 Services, for Program 354, Child Welfare Aid, to aid in carrying out  
 5 the provisions of Legislative Bill 949, One Hundred Second  
 6 Legislature, Second Session, 2012.

7           There is included in the appropriation to this program  
 8 for FY2012-13 \$156,111,873 General Funds, \$2,734,444 Cash Funds, and  
 9 \$30,676,983 Federal Funds estimate for state aid, which shall only be  
 10 used for such purpose.

11           There is included in the appropriation to this program  
 12 for FY2012-13 \$2,734,444 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care  
 13 Cash Fund for state aid for the continuation of the behavioral health  
 14 provider rate increase.

6 for FY2011-12 \$239,522,936 General Funds, \$6,044,444 Cash Funds, and  
7 \$141,003,570 Federal Funds estimate for state aid, which shall only  
8 be used for such purpose. There is included in the appropriation to  
9 this program for FY2012-13 ~~\$243,518,332~~\$87,406,459 General Funds,  
10 ~~\$6,044,444~~\$3,310,000 Cash Funds, and ~~\$132,464,624~~\$101,787,641  
11 Federal Funds estimate for state aid, which shall only be used for  
12 such purpose.

13                   There is included in the appropriation to this program  
14 for FY2011-12 \$810,000 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care Cash  
15 Fund for state aid to aid in carrying out the Nebraska Lifespan  
16 Respite Services Program and to provide payment to caregivers to  
17 purchase services under the respite subsidy program. There is  
18 included in the appropriation to this program for FY2012-13 \$810,000  
19 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund for state aid to  
20 aid in carrying out the Nebraska Lifespan Respite Services Program  
21 and to provide payment to caregivers to purchase services under the  
22 respite subsidy program.

23                   There is included in the appropriation to this program  
24 for FY2011-12 \$2,734,444 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care  
25 Cash Fund for state aid for the continuation of the behavioral health

1 provider rate increase. ~~There is included in the appropriation to~~

5 If Legislative Bill 985A, One Hundred Second Legislature,  
6 Second Session, 2012, becomes law, the reduction to the FY2012-13  
7 General Fund appropriation to Program 347 contained in Legislative  
8 Bill 985A, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012,  
9 shall not be made in Program 347 but shall be reduced from Program  
10 354.

11 If Legislative Bill 993A, One Hundred Second Legislature,  
12 Second Session, 2012, becomes law, the FY2012-13 and FY2013-14  
13 General Fund appropriations to Program 347 contained in Legislative  
14 Bill 993A, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012,  
15 shall be transferred to Program 354 and are hereby appropriated.

16 If Legislative Bill 820A, One Hundred Second Legislature,  
17 Second Session, 2012, becomes law, the FY2012-13 and FY2013-14  
18 General Fund appropriations to Program 347 contained in Legislative  
19 Bill 820A, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012,  
20 shall be transferred to Program 354 and are hereby appropriated.

21 If the home visitation program earmark contained in  
22 section 47, Legislative Bill 968, One Hundred Second Legislature,  
23 Second Session, 2012, becomes law, the earmark shall transfer to  
24 Program 354.

25 Sec. 3. Original Laws 2011, LB374, section 101, is

1 repealed.

2                   Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect

3 when passed and approved according to law.
