 3 to require certain facilities to offer vaccinations as

1 Section 1. Section 71-401, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 2 2011, is amended to read:
- 3 71-401 Sections 71-401 to 71-467 <u>and section 2 of this</u>
- 4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Health Care Facility
- 5 Licensure Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. <u>In order to prevent, detect, and control</u>
- 7 pneumonia and influenza outbreaks in Nebraska, each general acute
- 8 hospital, intermediate care facility, nursing facility, and skilled
- 9 nursing facility shall annually, beginning no later than October 1
- 10 and ending on the following April 1 when no national vaccine shortage
- 11 exists, offer onsite vaccinations for influenza and pneumococcal
- 12 <u>disease to all residents and to all inpatients prior to discharge,</u>
- 13 pursuant to procedures of the facility and in accordance with the
- 14 recommendations of the advisory committee on immunization practices
- 15 of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention of the United
- 16 States Public Health Service of the United States Department of
- 17 Health and Human Services as the recommendations existed on January
- 18 1, 2012.
