FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-3,104 and
    60-3,130.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and
    section 60-301, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2011; to
    provide for Beef State license plates; to harmonize
    provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,
```

Section 1. Section 60-301, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2011, is amended to read:

60-301 Sections 60-301 to 60-3,222 and sections 2 and 3 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Registration Act.

Sec. 2. (1) Beginning January 1, 2013, a person may apply for Beef State license plates in lieu of regular license plates on an application prescribed and provided by the department for any motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer, except for motor vehicles or trailers registered under section $60-3,198$. An applicant receiving a Beef State license plate for a farm truck with a gross weight of over sixteen tons or for a commercial motor vehicle registered for a gross weight of five tons or over shall affix the appropriate tonnage decal to the plate. The department shall make forms available for such applications. Each application for initial issuance or renewal of Beef State license plates shall be accompanied by a fee of seventy dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall be remitted to the State Treasurer. The State Treasurer shall credit fifteen percent of the fee for initial issuance and renewal of Beef State license plates to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund and eighty-five percent of the fee to the Highway Trust Fund.
(2) When the department receives an application for Beef State license plates, it shall deliver the plates to the county treasurer of the county in which the motor vehicle, trailer,

semitrailer, or cabin trailer is registered. The county treasurer
    shall issue Beef State license plates in lieu of regular license
    plates when the applicant complies with the other provisions of law
    for registration of the motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin
    trailer. If Beef State license plates are lost, stolen, or mutilated,
    the licensee shall be issued replacement license plates pursuant to
    section 60-3,157.
    (3)(a) The owner of a motor vehicle, trailer,
    semitrailer, or cabin trailer bearing Beef State license plates may
make application to the county treasurer to have such Beef State
license plates transferred to a motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer,
or cabin trailer other than the motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer,
or cabin trailer for which such plates were originally purchased if
such motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer is owned
by the owner of the Beef State license plates.
(b) The owner may have the unused portion of the Beef State license plate fee credited to the other motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer which will bear the Beef State license plates at the rate of eight and one-third percent per month for each full month left in the registration period.
(c) Application for such transfer shall be accompanied by a fee of three dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
Sec. 3. (1) The department, in designing Beef State

license plates, shall include the words The Beef State in the top
center of the license plate in white lettering on a black background.
    (2) One type of Beef State license plates shall be
consecutively numbered plates. The department shall:
    (a) Number the Beef State license plates consecutively
beginning with the number one, using numerals the size of which
maximizes legibility; and
    (b) Not use a county designation or any characters other
than numbers on the Beef State license plates.
    (3) One type of Beef State license plate shall be
personalized message plates. Such plates shall be issued subject to
the same conditions specified for message plates in subsection (2) of
section 60-3,118. The characters used shall consist only of letters
and numerals of the same size and design and shall comply with the
requirements of subdivision (1) (a) of section 60-3,100. A maximum of
seven characters may be used.

Sec. 5. Section 60-3,130.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

60-3,130.04 (1) An owner of a historical vehicle eligible for registration under section $60-3,130$ may use a license plate or plates designed by this state in the year corresponding to the model year when the vehicle was manufactured in lieu of the plates designed pursuant to section 60-3,130.03 subject to the approval of the department. The department shall inspect the plate or plates and may approve the plate or plates if it is determined that the model-year license plate or plates are legible and serviceable and that the license plate numbers do not conflict with or duplicate other numbers assigned and in use. An original-issued license plate or plates that have been restored to original condition may be used when approved by the department.
(2) The department may consult with a recognized car club in determining whether the year of the license plate or plates to be

used corresponds to the model year when the vehicle was manufactured.
    (3) If only one license plate is used on the vehicle, the
    license plate shall be placed on the rear of the vehicle. The owner
    of a historical vehicle may use only one plate on the vehicle even
    for years in which two license plates were issued for vehicles in
general.
(4) License plates used pursuant to this section corresponding to the year of manufacture of the vehicle shall not be personalized message license plates, Pearl Harbor license plates, prisoner-of-war license plates, disabled veteran license plates, Purple Heart license plates, amateur radio station license plates, Nebraska Cornhusker Spirit Plates, handicapped or disabled person license plates, er-specialty license plates, or Beef State license plates.
Sec. 6. Original sections \(60-3,104\) and 60-3,130.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 60-301, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2011, are repealed.
