**LEGISLATIVE BILL 1166**

Introduced by Ashford, 20.

A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to county government; to eliminate elective  
2 offices when approved by registered voters; to provide  
3 for appointment of certain county officials; and to  
4 declare an emergency.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. When approved by the registered voters of the  
2 county, for any vacancy in any of the following offices occurring on  
3 or after the effective date of this act, the county board of the  
4 county shall appoint the officer:

- 5           (1) County clerk;  
6           (2) Register of deeds;  
7           (3) County assessor;  
8           (4) County treasurer;  
9           (5) Clerk of the district court;  
10          (6) County surveyor; and  
11          (7) County engineer.

12           The appointed person shall be subject to removal by the  
13 county board. A person may be appointed to serve in more than one  
14 office.

15           Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect  
16 when passed and approved according to law.
