1	FOR AN	ACT relating to the Uniform Credentialing Act; to amend
2		section 38-129, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3		change provisions relating to issuance of credentials as
4		prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to
5		declare an emergency.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 38-129, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 38-129 No individual shall be issued a credential under 4 the Uniform Credentialing Act until he or she has furnished 5 satisfactory evidence to the department that he or she is of good б character and has attained the age of nineteen years except as 7 otherwise specifically provided by statute, rule, or regulation. A 8 credential may only be issued to a citizen of the United States, an 9 alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence into the United States who is eligible for a credential under the Uniform 10 11 Credentialing Act, or a nonimmigrant whose visa for entry, or 12 application for visa for entry, is related to such employment in the 13 United States. lawfully present in the United States who is eligible 14 for a credential under the Uniform Credentialing Act.

Sec. 2. Original section 38-129, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effectwhen passed and approved according to law.
