- FOR AN ACT relating to highways; to amend section 39-218, Reissue
  Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to allow certain signs
  along scenic byways as prescribed; and to repeal the
  original section.

1 Section 1. Section 39-218, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 39-218 No sign shall be erected which is visible from the
- 4 main-traveled way of any scenic byway except (1) directional and
- 5 official signs to include, but not be limited to, signs and notices
- 6 pertaining to natural wonders, scenic attractions, and historical
- 7 attractions, (2) signs, displays, and devices advertising the sale or
- 8 lease of property upon which such media are located, and—(3) signs,
- 9 displays, and devices advertising activities conducted on the
- 10 property on which such media are located, and (4) signs advertising
- 11 <u>businesses in any city or village when the city or village is located</u>
- 12 no more than five miles from the scenic byway on an access road off
- of the scenic byway and the access road is the only paved road into
- 14 the city or village. Signs which are allowed shall comply with the
- 15 standards and criteria established by rules and regulations of the
- 16 Department of Roads.
- 17 Sec. 2. Original section 39-218, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 18 of Nebraska, is repealed.
