A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to cities and villages; to amend sections
2 16-321.01 and 17-568.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3 Nebraska; to provide for the waiver of bidding procedures
4 as prescribed; to provide a duty for the Revisor of
5 Statutes; and to repeal the original sections.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any charter or statutory
2 provisions or restrictions, any municipal bidding procedure may be
3 waived by the city council of a city of the metropolitan class when
4 required to comply with any federal grant, loan, or program.

5 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding any charter or statutory
6 provisions or restrictions, any municipal bidding procedure may be
7 waived by the city council of a city of the primary class when
8 required to comply with any federal grant, loan, or program.

9 Sec. 3. Section 16-321.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
10 Nebraska, is amended to read:

11 16-321.01 Any municipal bidding procedure may be waived
12 by the city council or board of public works (1) when materials or
13 equipment are purchased at the same price and from the same seller as
14 materials or equipment which have formerly been obtained pursuant to
15 the state bidding procedure in sections 81-145 to 81-162, ~~or~~ (2) when
16 the contract is negotiated directly with a sheltered workshop
17 pursuant to section 48-1503, or (3) when required to comply with any
18 federal grant, loan, or program.

19 Sec. 4. Section 17-568.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of
20 Nebraska, is amended to read:

21 17-568.02 Any municipal bidding procedure may be waived
22 by the city council, village board, or board of public works (1) when
23 materials or equipment are purchased at the same price and from the
24 same seller as materials or equipment which have formerly been
25 obtained pursuant to the state bidding procedure in sections 81-145

1 to 81-162, ~~or~~ (2) when the contract is negotiated directly with a
2 sheltered workshop pursuant to section 48-1503, or (3) when required
3 to comply with any federal grant, loan, or program.

4 Sec. 5. The Revisor of Statutes shall assign section 1 of
5 this act to Chapter 14 and section 2 of this act to Chapter 15.

6 Sec. 6. Original sections 16-321.01 and 17-568.02,
7 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
