A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend section 2-2103, Reissue
- 2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to authorize funding for
- 3 the Beginning Farmer Tax Credit Act administration as
- 4 prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 2-2103, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 2-2103 (1) The Director of Agriculture, on behalf of the
4 State of Nebraska, is authorized to enter into an agreement with the
5 Secretary of Agriculture of the United States, upon such terms and
6 conditions and for such periods of time as may be mutually agreeable,
7 to accept, administer, expend, and use in the State of Nebraska all
8 or any part of the trust assets or any other funds made available
9 under the provisions of the federal act specified in section 2-2101.

10 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature that the director
11 seek to amend such agreements as necessary to authorize use of the
12 trust assets or any other funds made available under the provisions
13 of the federal act specified in 2-2101 to fund expenditures of the
14 department in administering the Beginning Farmer Tax Credit Act and
15 in provision of administrative support services for the Beginning
16 Farmer Board.
