# A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to state government; to require state agencies to
- 2 use Nebraska biodiesel fuel as prescribed.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. (1) Each state agency shall, not later than 2 ninety days after the effective date of this act, implement a program 3 of using Nebraska biodiesel fuel in motor vehicles owned or operated 4 by the agency which are designed to operate on diesel fuel. The 5 program shall require that a minimum of two percent of the agency's 6 annual diesel fuel usage be Nebraska biodiesel fuel. The program may 7 permit different blending ratios based upon seasonal differences. The 8 agency shall determine its monthly baseline petroleum diesel fuel 9 usage for 2009 and 2010 and shall determine its monthly petroleum 10 diesel fuel usage and Nebraska biodiesel fuel usage thereafter. Each agency shall report such data, including benchmarks for future 11 12 reductions in petroleum diesel usage and increases in Nebraska 13 biodiesel fuel usage, to the Natural Resources Committee of the 14 Legislature. The committee may recognize agencies that have 15 implemented the most effective programs. 16 (2) For purposes of this section, Nebraska biodiesel fuel means renewable diesel fuel that is produced in Nebraska that meets 17 American Society for Testing and Materials standards for diesel fuel 18 and other fuel quality requirements. 19 (3) An agency shall be required to comply with this 20 requirement only to the extent that Nebraska biodiesel fuel is 21 22 available.
