A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to the Assisted-Living Facility Act; to amend section 71-5905, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change requirements for operating assisted-living facilities; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 71-5905, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 71-5905 (1) An assisted-living facility shall not admit
- 4 or retain a resident who requires complex nursing interventions or
- 5 whose condition is not stable or predictable unless:
- 6 (a) The resident, if he or she is not a minor and is
- 7 competent to make a rational decision as to his or her needs or care,
- 8 or his or her authorized representative, and his or her physician or
- 9 a registered nurse agree that admission or retention of the resident
- 10 is appropriate;
- 11 (b) The resident or his or her authorized representative
- 12 agrees to arrange for the care of the resident through appropriate
- 13 private duty personnel, a licensed home health agency, or a licensed
- 14 hospice; and
- 15 (c) The resident's care does not compromise the facility
- 16 operations or create a danger to others in the facility.
- 17 (2) Health maintenance activities at an assisted-living
- 18 facility shall be performed in accordance with the Nurse Practice Act
- 19 and the rules and regulations adopted and promulgated under the act.
- 20 (3) Each assisted-living facility shall provide written
- 21 information about the practices of the assisted-living facility to
- 22 each applicant for admission to the facility or his or her authorized
- 23 <u>representative</u>. The information shall include:
- 24 (a) The services provided by the assisted-living
- 25 <u>facility;</u>

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1 (b) The number of staff employed by the assisted-living

- 2 facility;
- 3 (c) The charges for services provided by the assisted-
- 4 living facility;
- 5 (d) Whether or not the assisted-living facility accepts
- 6 residents who are eligible for the medical assistance program under
- 7 <u>the Medical Assistance Act and the number of beds that are set aside</u>
- 8 for residents whose care is paid by the medical assistance program;
- 9 <u>(e) The circumstance under which a resident would be</u>
- 10 required to leave an assisted-living facility;
- 11 <u>(f) The process for developing and updating the resident</u>
- 12 <u>services agreement; and</u>
- 13 (q) For facilities that have special care units for
- 14 <u>dementia</u>, the additional services provided to meet the special needs
- of persons with dementia.
