Section 1. Section 2-5422, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 2-5422 The Department of Economic Development shall 4 submit an annual report to the Governor and the Legislature on or 5 before January 1 include information on the grants made under the 6 Agricultural Opportunities and Value-Added Partnerships Act in the 7 department's annual status report under section 81-1201.11, which 8 shall include a listing of the recipients and grant amounts for 9 grants made under the Agricultural Opportunities and Value Added 10 Partnerships Act act in the previous year, the documented and measurable impacts of the grants, and an evaluation of 11 the 12 performance of the grant program based on the measurable goals and 13 expected outcomes of the recipients of such grants. Copies of the 14 program performance evaluation shall be made available through print 15 and electronic media.

16 Sec. 2. Section 13-2709, Reissue Revised Statutes of 17 Nebraska, is amended to read:

18 13-2709 The department shall submit, as part of the 19 department's annual status report under section 81-1201.11, 20 <u>information</u> to the Governor, the Clerk of the Legislature, and the 21 Legislative Fiscal Analyst an annual report on or before December 1 22 each year documenting the grants conditionally approved for funding 23 by the Legislature in the following fiscal year.

24 Sec. 3. Section 58-711, Reissue Revised Statutes of 25 Nebraska, is amended to read:

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1 58-711 The Department of Economic Development shall 2 submit, as part of the department's annual status report under 3 section 81-1201.11, information detailing the status of the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. an annual report to the Legislature no 4 5 later than March 15th of each year. The status report shall list (1) 6 the applications funded during the previous calendar year, (2) the 7 applications funded in previous years, (3) the identity of the 8 organizations receiving funds, (4) the location of each project, (5) 9 the amount of funding provided to the project, (6) the amount of funding leveraged as a result of the project, (7) the number of units 10 11 of housing created by the project and the occupancy rate, (8) the 12 expected cost of rent or monthly payment of those units, (9) the 13 projected number of new employees and community investment as a 14 result of the project, and (10) the amount of revenue deposited into 15 the Affordable Housing Trust Fund pursuant to sections 8-1120 and 16 76-903. The status report shall contain no information that is protected by state or federal confidentiality laws. 17

18 Sec. 4. Section 81-1201.11, Reissue Revised Statutes of 19 Nebraska, is amended to read:

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81-1201.11 The department shall:

(1) Serve as the lead state agency in the area of economic development. The department shall develop a program to promote coordination and cooperation within state government and with institutions of higher education, local governments, other political subdivisions of the state, and the private sector;

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1 (2) Serve as a clearinghouse for information, data, and 2 other materials which may be helpful or necessary to the full 3 development of the state's economy, which may be relevant with regard to the possibilities of future development in Nebraska, and which 4 5 will be of use to local governments, the Governor, other state agencies, and the Legislature in discharging their responsibilities. 6 7 The department shall develop a program to ensure cooperation between 8 state agencies, the University of Nebraska, and other entities with 9 related economic information; (3) Provide staff services when, in the opinion of the 10 director, such services are necessary and appropriate in the areas of 11 12 economic development to cities of the first class, second class, and 13 villages on a contractual basis when the terms of such contracts can 14 be mutually accepted; (4) Assist the Governor in coordinating the efforts of 15 local governments to develop mutual and cooperative solutions to 16 17 their common problems; and 18 (5) Prepare annually a status report on the activities 19 and impacts of the department and its programs. The status report 20 shall include information detailing the status of all programs administered by the department for which the Legislature requires 21 reporting. The status report shall be submitted to the Governor and 22 23 the Legislature on the first working day of October July of each 24 year.

Sec. 5. Section 81-1205, Revised Statutes Cumulative

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1 Supplement, 2010, is amended to read:

2 81-1205 A business which is awarded a job training grant 3 or a training grant shall provide annual performance reports to the 4 Department of Economic Development and a final performance report 5 upon the completion of the project. The department shall provide an 6 annual report by December 1 of each year to the Appropriations 7 Committee of the Legislature. include information relating to such 8 grants in the department's annual status report under section <u>81-1201.11.</u> The <u>status</u> report shall include information on each 9 10 active grant, including specific information regarding the number of positions to be trained, whether new or existing employees are to be 11 12 trained, the length of time that the project has been active, the 13 amount of funding committed to the project, the amount of funding paid out to date, and the projected completion date. The status 14 15 report shall also provide information on grants closed during the reporting year, including the total number of employees trained, 16 whether new or existing employees were trained, total project 17 expenditures, and the duration time of the project. The department 18 status report shall also provide information summarizing the use of 19 20 community college areas to provide training services and list 21 specific projects where a community college area is providing all or 22 a component of the training services. If private or inhouse training 23 services are used, the department status report shall provide information regarding the name of the private or inhouse training 24 25 service and the qualifications of the training service.

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Sec. 6. Section 81-1277, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 81-1277 The Existing Business Assistance Division shall 4 require, as a condition of contracts awarded under the Business 5 Development Services Program, satisfactory quarterly reports from 6 recipients describing services provided, clients served, and 7 expenditures. The division shall provide an annual report to the 8 Legislature which describes include, as part of the Department of 9 Economic Development's annual status report under section 81-1201.11, 10 a description of the services provided under the Business Development Partnership Act, analyzes an analysis of the impact of the services, 11 12 makes recommendations regarding the services, and evaluates an 13 evaluation of the performance of service deliverers.

Sec. 7. Section 81-12,104, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

16 81-12,104 The department shall submit, as part of the 17 department's annual status report under section 81-1201.11, 18 information an annual report to the Governor and the Legislature on 19 or before January 1 of each year which shall include, but not be 20 limited to, a description of the demand for the program from 21 microenterprises and grant recipients in Nebraska, a listing of the 22 recipients and amounts of grants made pursuant to the Microenterprise 23 Development Act in the previous fiscal year, the impact of the 24 grants, a description of the partnerships between commercial lending 25 institutions and microloan delivery organizations that have resulted

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1 from grants made by the program, and an evaluation of the program's 2 performance based on the documented goals of the recipients. The 3 department may require program recipients to provide periodic 4 performance reports to enable the department to fulfill the 5 requirements of this section.

6 Sec. 8. Section 81-12,135, Reissue Revised Statutes of
7 Nebraska, is amended to read:

8 81-12,135 The Department of Economic Development shall 9 submit an annual report on information regarding its activities under 10 the Nebraska Operational Assistance Act to the Governor and the Clerk 11 of the Legislature on or before January 1 each year. as part of the 12 department's annual status report under section 81-1201.11.

Sec. 9. Section 81-3605, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

15 81-3605 On or before February 15 July 1 of each year, the 16 executive director of the Rural Development Commission shall transmit 17 submit_to the Governor and the Clerk of the Legislature Department of 18 Economic Development an annual report which includes a summary of the commission's activities, recommendations for future rural development 19 20 action, and an accounting of the source and use of funds disbursed 21 during the previous fiscal year. The Department of Economic 22 Development shall include such report in the department's annual 23 status report under section 81-1201.11.
