A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicle park entry permits; to amend
2 section 37-438, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and
3 section 37-440, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
4 2010; to change fees for annual and temporary permits and
5 fees for issuance of the permits; to provide an operative
6 date; and to repeal the original sections.

7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 37-438, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 37-438 (1) The commission shall devise permits in two
4 forms: Annual and temporary.

5 (2) The annual permit may be purchased by any person and
6 shall be valid through December 31 in the year for which the permit
7 is issued. The fee for the annual permit for a resident motor vehicle
8 shall be not more than ~~twenty~~ twenty-five dollars per permit. The fee
9 for the annual permit for a nonresident motor vehicle shall not be
10 more than ~~twenty-five~~ thirty dollars. The commission shall establish
11 such fees by the adoption and promulgation of rules and regulations.

12 (3) A temporary permit may be purchased by any person and
13 shall be valid until noon of the day following the date of issue. The
14 fee for the temporary permit for a resident motor vehicle shall be
15 not more than ~~four~~ five dollars. The fee for the temporary permit for
16 a nonresident motor vehicle shall not be more than ~~five~~ six dollars.
17 The commission shall establish such fees by the adoption and
18 promulgation of rules and regulations. The commission may issue
19 temporary permits which are either valid for any area or valid for a
20 single area.

21 Sec. 2. Section 37-440, Revised Statutes Cumulative
22 Supplement, 2010, is amended to read:

23 37-440 (1) The commission shall prescribe the type and
24 design of permits and the method of display of permits for motor
25 vehicles. The commission may provide for the electronic issuance of

1 permits and may enter into contracts to procure necessary services
2 and supplies for the electronic issuance of permits.

3 (2) The permits may be procured from the central and
4 district offices of the commission, at areas of the Nebraska state
5 park system where commission offices are maintained, from self-
6 service vending stations at designated park areas, from designated
7 commission employees, through Internet sales from the commission's
8 web site, from appropriate offices of county government, and from
9 various private persons, firms, or corporations designated by the
10 commission as permit agents. The commission and county offices or
11 private persons, firms, or corporations designated by the commission
12 as permit agents shall be entitled to collect and retain a fee of ~~not~~
13 ~~less than twenty-five cents and not more than thirty-five cents, one~~
14 dollar, as established by the commission pursuant to section 37-327,
15 for each permit as reimbursement for the clerical work of issuing the
16 permits and remitting therefor. The commission shall be entitled to
17 collect and retain a fee of one dollar for each permit sold through
18 its web site as reimbursement for the clerical work and postage
19 associated with issuing the permit.

20 Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2012.

21 Sec. 4. Original section 37-438, Reissue Revised Statutes
22 of Nebraska, and section 37-440, Revised Statutes Cumulative
23 Supplement, 2010, are repealed.
